TRAVEL INFORMATION


TRAIN: 8 minutes walk from Edinburgh Waverley Station. Take station footbridge to the Market Street exit. Cross Market Street and follow Fleshmarket Close steps up to Cockburn St turning left and left again into High St.

No steps route: Exit station by South or North ramp, turn left onto Waverley Bridge, continue along Cockburn St and turn left into High St.

BUS: most city bus services stop in Princes Street. Carrubbers Christian Centre is 10 minutes walk via North Bridge.

PARK & RIDE: There are seven park and ride services into the city. More details at www.edinburgh.gov.uk

PARKING: Holyrood Park car park, Queens Drive (off London Road A1) is 10 minutes walk away. Free on Saturdays. Walk past Scottish Parliament Building and then left into Canongate and continue into High St.

DR MARC SURTEES has a PhD in Zoology and works part time in the pharmaceutical industry. Marc also owns and runs a creation-based science and nature shop in Edinburgh.



DOMINIC STATHAM CMI UK/Europe, is a Chartered Engineer. He spent twenty-five years working in manufacturing and product development with Rolls Royce (Aero Division) and GKN Driveline, a leading supplier to the automotive industry. He is the author of *Evolution: Good Science? Exposing the ideological nature of Darwin's theory.*



PHILIP BELL is CEO of CMI UK/Europe. After studying zoology and geology at university (graduating in zoology), he worked in cancer research (nine years), then as a high school science teacher. Since 2001, he has written widely on Creation/science topics and has addressed audiences throughout the UK and in many countries overseas.



PAUL JAMES-GRIFFITHS worked as a West End Theatre Chaplain in shows like *Cats* and *Phantom of the Opera*, and was a missionary to the New Age Movement for six years. Since 2004 he has been working with Edinburgh City Mission. He now runs an historical walking tour and has pioneered Edinburgh Creation Group next to the University of Edinburgh where he works with students.
