**DR BENNO ZUIDDAM** is a minister in the Dutch Reformed Church, teaches Christian ethics at the Free University (Amsterdam), and is a research associate of North West University (South Africa). He holds a D.Th. in Church history and a Ph.D. in Greek. Research focus: divine revelation and implications for a Christian worldview and ethics.



**DR ROGER LIEBI** has an M.Mus., B.Th., M.Th., and Th.D. He has studied music, languages of the Biblical world (Greek, Classical and modern Hebrew, Aramaic), and theology. As a university teacher he taught Archaeology of Israel and the Middle East from 2004–2011. He is active as a Bible teacher in various countries and is the author of numerous books.



**SUSAN JONES** has a B.Sc. in Physics and a PGCE teaching certificate from Southampton University. For over 15 years, she taught physics, chemistry, and biology at both private and state secondary schools. Director of *Creation Family Science*, which she founded in 2011, she is passionate about communicating her faith in God and enthusiasm for science.



**ANDREW SIBLEY** holds a B.Sc. in natural sciences, M.Sc. in Environmental Decision Making (Open University), and M.Phil. in theology (Exeter University). He took early retirement in 2021 after 38 years as a meteorologist for the UK Met Office, joining CMI staff as a writer and speaker. He is author of *Restoring the Ethics of Creation*.

An associate speaker with CMI, he is the pastor of Calvary Chapel Hastings on England's south coast. He is the author of several books, including *Who Am I? Human Identity and the Gospel in a Confusing World*.



**RAMÓN GÓMEZ** has a B.Th. from the Instituto Bíblico y Seminario Teológico de España, a B.A., and recently gained an M.Sc. in Science and Society from the Open University (UK), on the implications of new DNA-editing technologies (CRISP).
